

Hello and welcome to Maytime Melodies 2023

This is an extra special concert this year as not only is it our first Maytime Melodies since 2018 but it is also the 40th anniversary of St. Canice's Music Programme.

Founded in 1983 by Regina O'Leary and Peggy Carey with just 6 violin students each, the programme grew to great heights over the next 35 years. Just before the Covid 19 pandemic entered our lives and massively changed all aspects of life, there were up to 500 children accessing music through the music programme each year. Indeed, the arts was affected in such a detrimental way that all music in our school was halted immediately. Following a tentative reintroduction of classes where possible, adhering to all health & safety measures, we were finally able to offer a full timetable for students in September. Whilst our numbers are much smaller than previous years, it has been absolutely wonderful to hear music along the corridors of the school again. Normally in the concert programme we would list and detail the schedule of musical activities and achievements involving the children over the previous year but I think the biggest and most rewarding achievement for us in quite some time is just having the children on stage tonight.

Tonight's celebration of the music programme is not the only highlight of our year however. The annual Christmas Breakfast Morning reverted back to a huge morning of festivities following a scaled back version the previous two years. The children had a wonderful morning with over 100 litres of hot chocolate and a vast array of Christmas jumpers. A huge amount of money was raised so thank you to all those who contributed, sponsored, and helped out on the day.

With such large numbers involved in music it would be impossible to continue the smooth integration of the programme into school life without your support.

On that note, I would like to say a massive thank you to our retired principal, Maria Comerford. Maria has always been a champion of music in St. Canice's and a huge personal support to me. She was especially encouraging during the reintroduction of our first few string classes after Covid restrictions had been lifted. Her advice, words of wisdom and shared love of music has helped the music programme become the success it is today. Many thanks to you Maria and we wish you many years of health and happiness following your retirement.

Like most things in life, team work makes everything easier, more manageable, and much more efficient. Luckily, I am surrounded by a terrific team of parents in the music programme and whenever extra hands are needed, they are quick to offer support. When thanking parents, it is essential I mention my own mother tonight. She encouraged my brothers and I, along with many other children over the years to experience the joy of music. Her love of music and commitment to ensuring that all children can access music, along with years of hard work and dedication has shaped St. Canice's Music Programme into the national success that it is today. I am so grateful to her and extremely proud of everything she achieved. It would have been a very special moment for her to see her eldest grandchild perform for the first time in Maytime Melodies tonight.

On returning to Ireland, she completed a Bachelor of Education Degree in St. Patrick's College, Drumcondra, whilst continuing her musical studies in the Royal Irish Academy of Music, with William Butt, completing an Associate Diploma in Cello Teaching. During her time in St. Patrick's College, Ruth developed an interest in conducting and conducted the St. Patrick's College Choir in the Cork International Choral Festival with great success in May 2008. This led her to return to St. Patrick's College to participate in a Postgraduate Diploma in Choral Conducting in Schools and the Community. She has now returned to Kilkenny and is member of the staff of St. Canice's National School and the staff of St. Canice's Instrumental Music Programme.

She teaches cello to children from Senior Infant to 6th class level in the school, as well as chamber music and directing the school orchestra at present. She has recently started adult cello classes in the school for any parents who wish to join their children in their musical study. This has been set up with a view to providing cellists for the establishment of Kilkenny Gateway Orchestra.

Brianna Campbell - Cello

Brianna began her journey in music at a young age in St. John of God Primary School, Kilkenny, where she took piano lessons. While continuing to play the piano, Brianna began Double Bass lessons under the direction of Philip Edmondson in the Kilkenny
