Instrument Hire Contract:

It is the requirement of the borrower to maintain the instrument at their own cost while on loan from the Instrumental programme. (i.e. if an instrument gets damaged, string or bow breaks that the borrower arranges to have it fixed back to the standard that they initially received it on loan).
Strings are available for replace at a cost of €5, bows at a replace cost of €25, both from Mrs Morrissey. Reed's for Saxophone €3 from Eamonn Cahill.
All repairs to instruments must be carried out by qualified repairers, please contact your music teacher.

** Wind Instruments are only hired to pupils for 2 years from the programme, after the 2 years if the pupil wishes to continue they must purchase their own instrument
